CFJ administers a number of programs that seek to educate and inspire people to live their faith in action and to work for a just society. In 2010, hundreds of youth and young adults have participated in JusticeworX, ServiceworX, LeaderworX and additional CFJ programs, contributing over 20,000 hours of community service in New Jersey, Philadelphia and West Virginia. CFJ also partners with area parishes, schools and not-for-profit organizations to provide trained and supported youth and social concern ministers and to develop leaders of faith and service through its Students of Faith in Action, or SOFIA, project.



Helen Sanford is one of the founders of CFJ, and is a former member of the Board of Trustees. Over the past eleven years, she and her husband Art have worked tirelessly on behalf of the students who have participated in the CFJ programs. Mrs. Sanford is currently Campus Ministry Director at Immaculata High School. Through its support of CFJ, Immaculata has continued its tradition of offering students ongoing opportunities service, justice education and leadership development.
